The FoodBerlin research network (www.foodberlin.de) connects 40 university working groups and research institutions in the Berlin area in order to intensify cooperation in research and teaching. The joint research focuses on sustainable design of food production, processing and marketing. In order to interest



international students in working in Berlin or perform their doctoral studies here, FoodBerlin and the International

Department of Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin will hold a two-week summer school on the topic "Sustainable Diets". This interdisciplinary topic combines agricultural and natural sciences, veterinary medicine, as well as social and economic sciences.



When? June 30 - July 12, 2019

Where? Berlin, Germany

First week: Courses for international AND German students provided by highly qualified scientists from the FoodBerlin network:

- Social and political framework conditions for sustainability,
 - Agricultural production under the conditions of climate change,
 - Intensive crop production,
 - Animal health and welfare,
 - Food safety,
 - Psychology of nutrition,
 - Overeating as a problem,
 - Malnutrition and hidden hunger,
 - Challenges of world nutrition.
- ❖ Opportunity to establish contacts to professors, young Berlin scientists.

Second week: For international students with DAAD fellowship: Small group work on concrete topics:

- Discussions at high-profile institutions,
- Carrying out experiments in practical courses,
- Preparing a small report.



Round off the scientific program:

- Keynote Discussions by the renowned speakers Roberta Sonnino (Cardiff University, UK) and Frank Fischer (Rutgers University, NJ, USA).
- Joint excursions in and around Berlin as well as an attractive cultural and social program to familiarize the participants with German culture and create personal connections.
